Crafting writing at Key Stage 2

This day's training is suitable for key stage 2 class teachers and English subject leaders who wish to develop the way they teach writing composition through a 'reading into writing' approach. It will revisit key principles that underpin the writing process, explore the implications for teaching, and introduce creative ways of harnessing pupils' knowledge of grammar to make them better writers.

It will focus on the following:

- Considering what good readers and good writers do
- Drawing on reading to inform writing
- Teaching the writing process through modelled and shared writing
- Supporting the application of learning through guided writing
- Using grammar to improve writing through 'creative imitation'

Jo has been a teacher, a local authority adviser, an Ofsted inspector, and a member of the DfE Effective Practice Team. Now an independent consultant, she has worked on behalf of the Standards and Testing Agency on the teacher assessment of writing and on the grammar, punctuation and spelling test. She is the author of 'Grammar Survival for Primary Teachers' and has worked with primary and secondary schools in Suffolk since 2012.
