Outline:

What? Understanding the roles and responsibilities of the role of a subject leader

How? Through monitoring and evaluating (AEIOU)

Audit of achievement, resources, extra-curricular visits, activities, visitors

Evidence – exploring the range of evidence which will show success in learning from books to classrooms; highlighting the importance of a whole school book scrutiny

'I' – recognising the importance of people of all ages – pupils', parents' and staff views; enabling governors; linking with other leaders in wider networks; professional development

Observation – and what this entails, the importance of feedback and focus

Understanding all of the above and what to do next – how do you show your contribution to school development?

Considering your views:

A personal analysis – strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, threats – identifying challenges

How do you make a positive difference? What can you do to manage your time most effectively? In which ways are you a champion for your subject? What actions can you take that will have an impact?

Action Planning for the future – analysing your own circumstances, how can you show a purposeful direction for future improvement in your subject across the school?
