Course overview

These sessions will provide an understanding of the evidence around early language development and the crucial role early language development plays in learning for all children. It will focus on developing provision to support effective vocabulary across Early Years, KS1 and KS2.

Delegates will need to bring with them an understanding of their own schools data and what it tells them in order to be able to reflect and develop strategies for their school which are both practical and time efficient so that they can be embedded into daily teaching and learning.



Intended Impact

- To develop an approach / action plan of how vocabulary will be developed either as role of Literacy lead or as a class teacher.
- To know what the impact has been and how it will be measured.
- To track specific children in order to measure progress.
- To deliver short term outcomes such as improved command of a rich variety of words and improved comprehension of relevant concepts.
- To deliver long term outcomes such as improved reading comprehension, improved phonological awareness and improved decoding strategies.
